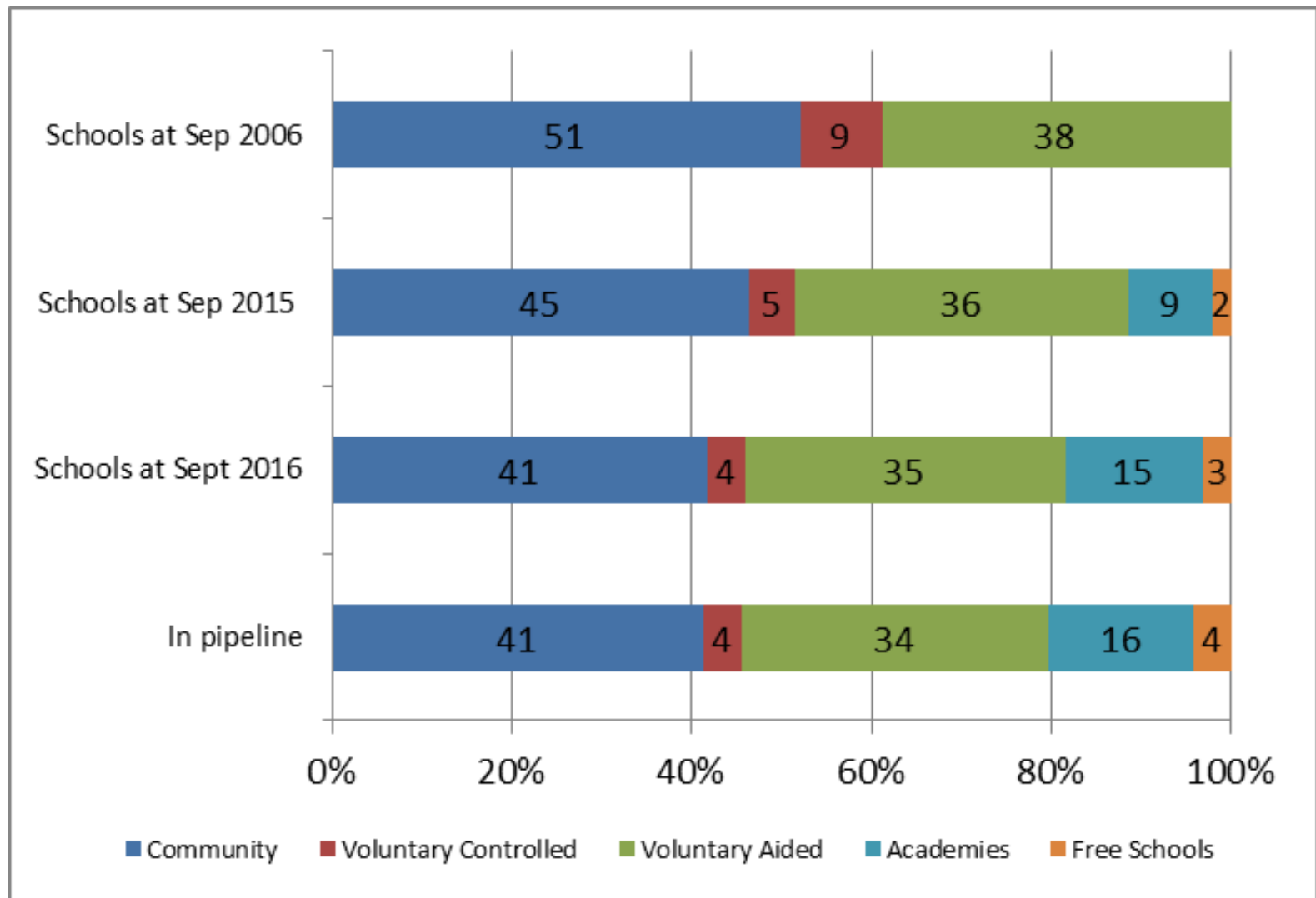
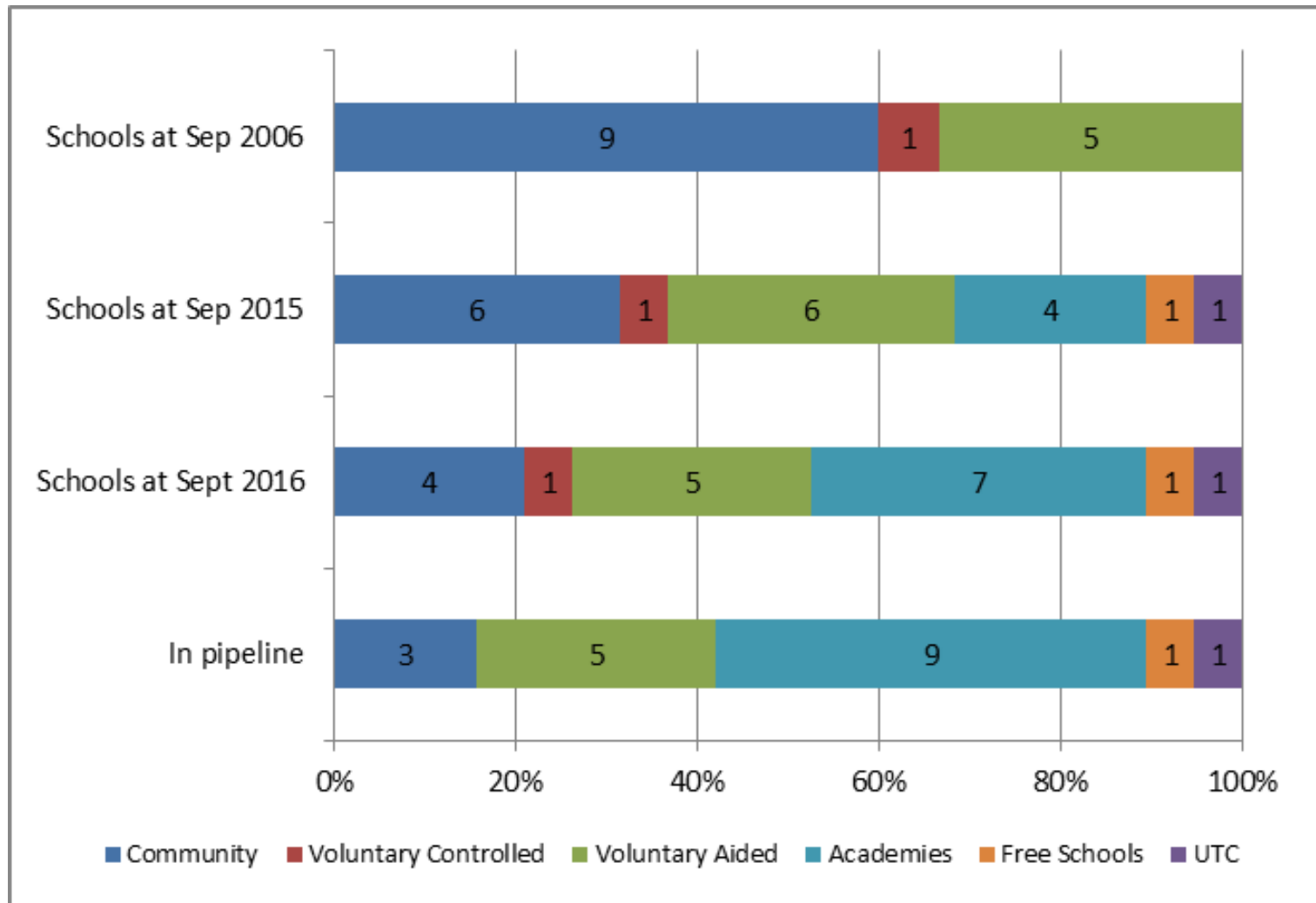

# Government Policy on Schools

<b>2015</b>	<b>Conservative party manifesto – expansion of academies, free schools and UTCs. 500 new free schools by 2020.</b>
March 16	Educational Excellence Everywhere white paper. Headline - all state-funded schools to become academies by 2022. As LA responsibilities diminish, they will retain functions in ensuring every child has a school place, ensuring the needs of vulnerable pupils are met and acting as champions for parents and families.
May 16	Nicky Morgan announces blanket conversion legislation is not needed but will introduce legislation to trigger conversion of all schools within a LA where: i) a critical mass of schools have already converted, or ii) minimum performance thresholds not met across schools.
Sep 16	Schools that Work for Everyone green paper. Headline – re-introduction of selective education. Consultation open until Dec.
Oct 16	Justine Greening written statement – no changes needed to education legislation in this Parliamentary session. Focus is now on building capacity and encouraging voluntary conversion.
