1	Deane Church Lane is currently being resurfaced and local residents would prefer that the speed humps were not replaced.	Environmental Services	<p>At the time the question was raised 6<sup>th</sup> February 2014, the speed humps had already been replaced. Feedback from Environmental Services is as follows:</p> <p>Speed humps are only constructed at sites with significant accident history; the positions are agreed after a large public consultation exercise and the Highways Scrutiny committee has to approve them. The same exercise would need to be followed if they were to be removed – Consequently unless we had evidence that the majority of the community now opposed the humps <i>and</i> it could be demonstrated that they were ineffective at controlling traffic speeds they are always replaced during resurfacing works in exactly the same positions.</p>
