- Reduction in the Grant from the Council of £1,400,000 (45% of operational fee)
- Five Facilities now down from 13
- Investment in excess of £2,500,000
- Income increased by £500,000



Interesting Facts

- All concrete from the car park has been crushed on site
- The amount of crushed material would fill an Olympic size swimming pool
- The crushed material will be reused in the foundations of the new leisure centre and Chorley New Road School
- The metal from the car park has been recycled and will eventually go to India to be used in construction of coal mines
- At one point during demolition there was over £1 million worth of machinery on site
- 625 locally purchased bacon butties were consumed during demolition contributing £1125 to the local economy


