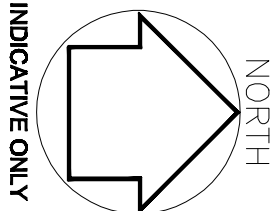

PROPOSED FEATURES

- PROPOSED FENCED PLANTATIONS - Feathered native species to maintain view through site steel fencing to countryside character
- PROPOSED AVENUE TREE PLANTING
- Shrub mature ornamental species planted at 5 metre spacings
- Native white planted at 1.00m
- PROPOSED REINFORCED BANKING
- Native white planted at 1 metre spacings eg Hawthorn, grass, willow, elder, holly
- Proposed landscaped areas to entrance
- Proposed access tracks
- Proposed footpaths
- PROPOSED SEATING AREAS - To include hard surfacing, seating and bins
- Proposed 1.5 metre high steel frontage railings
- Proposed 1.8 metre high steel mesh boundary fencing
- Land to be managed as wildlife corridor
