# 1. Welcome and Apologies

TB welcomed everyone to the meeting.

#### 2. Minutes of the Last Meeting

## 4. Review of action plan

The High Needs Action Plan was presented to the meeting.

An update on the Secondary SEMH project is required at the next meeting

TB confirmed that there have been 70+ permanent exclusions since September, most of these children need an alternative provision.

JE confirmed that she will bring the 19/20 start position to the next meeting.

### 5. AP tender dynamic purchasing

The alternative provision proposal went live on 22<sup>nd</sup> March – it has now been put on the chest so providers can start to prepare their bids. TB confirmed that there has been a lot of interest in this from various providers and that it will help to create a framework of providers who we can use flexibly and help to manage price and quality effectively over time.

#### 6. Primary/Secondary SEMH update

The proposal has now been approved by Committee and expressions of interest have been collated – 6 providers have come forward to apply. The next steps would be to look at individuals to sit on the interview panel.

### 7. SEND demand strategy

TB explained that a consultant named Rebecca Godar visited the LA to talk about demand around special school places. Rebecca has been commissioned to do some work around this. There are 2 points specifically that she is working on:

- What we need to do as a Local Authority to meet need in the future?
- What strategy are we going to take to address demand?

Action: Rebecca will attend the next meeting to discuss the work she is doing in more detail.

## 8. Pre EHCP funding for children with significant needs

DF presented an updated proposal for pre EHCP funding to the panel following the previous meeting. The proposal utilises the resources and expertise within the High Needs Bases

**Action:** DF to run the proposal through HR and present it at the next Inclusion and Engagement meeting and DLT. DF to find out more about the skill set which the outreach member of staff will require and approach head teachers discuss the proposal along with JE.
