Resolved - That the various planning applications submitted by the Director of Place be dealt with as follows:-

03818/18	Erection of three four storey buildings comprising 12 x 2 bedroom apartments and 18 five bed shared multiple occupancy units, together with associated access, parking and landscaping on land at Minerva Road, Farnworth, Bolton	Refused. 1.The proposed development would, by virtue of its scale, height and siting appear as an overbearing development which would have a detrimental impact on the character and appearance of the area and is contrary to policies CG3 and RA2.14 - RA2.16 (inclusive) of Bolton's Core Strategy and guidance contained within Supplementary Planning Document - "General Design Principles".

2.The proposed development would, by virtue of its design, height and siting and compounded by the change in levels between the application site and the surrounding residential dwellings, impact detrimentally on the privacy, amenity and living conditions of neighbouring residents on **Kingsland Road** and Colchester **Drive and would** be contrary to policies CG4 and **RA2.17** of **Bolton's Core** Strategy and guidance contained within **Supplementary Planning** Document -"General Design Principles".

3.The proposed site layout would result in the communal

amenity space for future residents being dislocated from the occupants of Blocks 1 and 2, and would thus result in an unusable external space for the occupants of Blocks 1 and 2. This would impact detrimentally on the living conditions of **future residents** and would be contrary to **Bolton's Core Strategy policies CG4 and RA2.17** and guidance contained within Supplementary **Planning Document -**"General Design Principles".
