#### 7. MINUTES

The minutes of the proceedings of the meeting of the School Governor Appointments Panel held on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 were submitted.

### 8. EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

# 9. APPOINTMENT/RE-APPOINTMENT OF LOCAL AUTHORITY GOVERNORS

The Director of Children's Services submitted a report which requested members to consider the appointment/re-appointment of Local Authority Governors in accordance with the Bolton Code of Practice.

He also tabled a copy of the current criteria / person specification for appointments.

Mr. Ashworth also explained to the meeting that HM Government was conducting a consultation exercise in respect of the constitution of governing bodies of maintained schools in England. The consultation sets out proposed changes to the regulations and guidance that govern the constitution of governing bodies and federations of maintained schools in England.

The meeting was informed that the main context of the proposal was to simplify the overall legislative framework by ensuring there was a single consistent approach across all maintained schools and enable more effective governance by ensuring that the key consideration in decisions about constitution and membership of governing bodies was the skills required to be effective.

Mr. Ashworth went on to explain matters around the envisaged key changes and the lieky impact on the Authority.

In conclusion, it was indicated, that the consultation was launched on 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2014 and would close on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2014. HM Government's intention was to lay amendments to the regulations in the spring of 2014, to come into force from 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2014.

Chairs of Governors had been informed of the consultation on 20<sup>th</sup> January, 2014.
