

Schedule of Telecoms Equipment on Bolton MBC land

1) Stapleton Avenue –green field site

Agreement with Orange for a term of 9 years from 30 September 1999 at an annual fee of £11,162, subject to reviews every three years. The agreement allows for a 25 metre mast and a variety equipment which has been added to over the years when proposals to share the facility have been put forward. The site now accommodates equipment owned by Vodafone, O2 and Hutchison 3g.

2) Duddon Avenue – garage colony

Agreement with Orange for a term of 10 years from 11 June 1998 at an annual fee of £6,000, subject to review every three years. The agreement allows for a 15 metre mast and associated equipment.

3) Rainford House - flats

Agreement with Orange for a term of 9 years from 30 October 1998 at an annual fee of £8,600, subject to review every three years. The agreement allows for various equipment on the roof together with an equipment cabin at ground level.

4) Horwich Leisure Centre

Agreement with Orange for a term of 9 years from 31 December 1998 at an annual fee of £5,500, subject to review every three years. The agreement provides for a 15 metre mast and associated equipment.

5) Brandwood Street School – primary school

Agreement with Orange for a term of 10 years from 28 April 1998 at an annual fee of £5,500, subject to review every three years and currently under review. The agreement allows for various equipment within the roof turret and equipment cabins in the cellar.

NB Bow Street Car Park – There is equipment on the roof of Bow Street Car Park but the agreement is administered by APCOA via the management contract for the car park.

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
