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1. Introduction

Since the introduction of the Food Safety Act 1990, regular deep cleaning of kitchen extraction systems is seen as required due diligence helping to minimise risks and safeguarding reputations. It also increases life expectancy and improves efficiency of expensive catering equipment. It is a prerequisite for validity of insurance cover in the event of fire within kitchens that all ventilation cleaning is carried out to BESA (Building and Engineering Services Association) accredited companies

2. Types of contracts required under Standing Orders

- 2.1. Up to £15,000 Decision whether to invite tenders/quotations to be made by Chief Officer, or designated officer.
- 2.2. £15,000 £50,000 Requirements should be specified in writing, and wherever possible, a minimum of three written quotations obtained, by a specified time and date.
- 2.3. Over £50,000 £172,514 EU Threshold
 Tenders must be invited by advertisement via The Chest.

2.4. £172,514 EU Threshold

If the estimated expenditure of the total contract is likely to exceed EU financial thresholds, then EU legislation/procedures apply. Tenders must be advertised in the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU)

3. Financial Information

- 3.1 Current contract value over the let period is £65,000
- 3.2 Schedule: This contract will cover the annual ventilation cleaning required as a minimum for 98 primary and 4 Secondary Schools. Due to the nature of Civic Catering, provision is made for a biannual service.
- 3.4 By providing this service to schools the risks of serious damage to school buildings is mitigated, protecting the Authorities asset and safeguarding employees.
