2. NEIGHBOURHOOD AND REGULATORY SERVICES SAVINGS AND EFFICIENCIES

By way of background information, the report explained that the Council had to make savings of £43.4 million over the next two years and Neighbourhood and Regulatory Services were required to save £1,315,000 from the current budget of £8,905,000.

The report set out the specific details of the proposals which were now for the purposes of consultation.

Members were also informed that it was anticipated that the final proposals would be considered in July, 2013 with a revised structure in place by October,

2013.
