- 1. TRANSFER OF GENERAL SAFETY CERTIFICATE AND ISSUE OF SPECIAL SAFETY CERTIFICATE FOR ROD STEWART CONCERT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF BOLTON STADIUM, BURNDEN WAY, LOSTOCK**

The Director of Place submitted a report which sought approval for the transfer of the General Safety Certificate for the University of Bolton Stadium and for the issue of a Special Safety Certificate under the Safety at Sports Grounds Act 1975 and the Safety at Sports Grounds Regulations 1987 for the forthcoming Rod Stewart Concert at the University of Bolton Stadium on Friday 14th June, 2019.

The Executive Cabinet Member was advised that a General Safety Certificate must already be in force for a designated ground before a Special Safety Certificate could be issued for this type of event and the current General Safety Certificate 2018 edition was reviewed and re-issued on 10th September, 2018. It was also stated that the Club's Joint Administrator's had requested a transfer of the General Safety Certificate.

It was also explained that a Special Safety Certificate was required for a designated ground to hold a special event at a sports ground where the event was not listed as a specified activity in the General Safety Certificate and the proposed concert was not a specified activity in the current General Safety Certificate.

The Executive Cabinet Member was informed that the Event Specific Management Plan and Capacity Calculations for both Ingress and Egress had been provided for the Concert.
