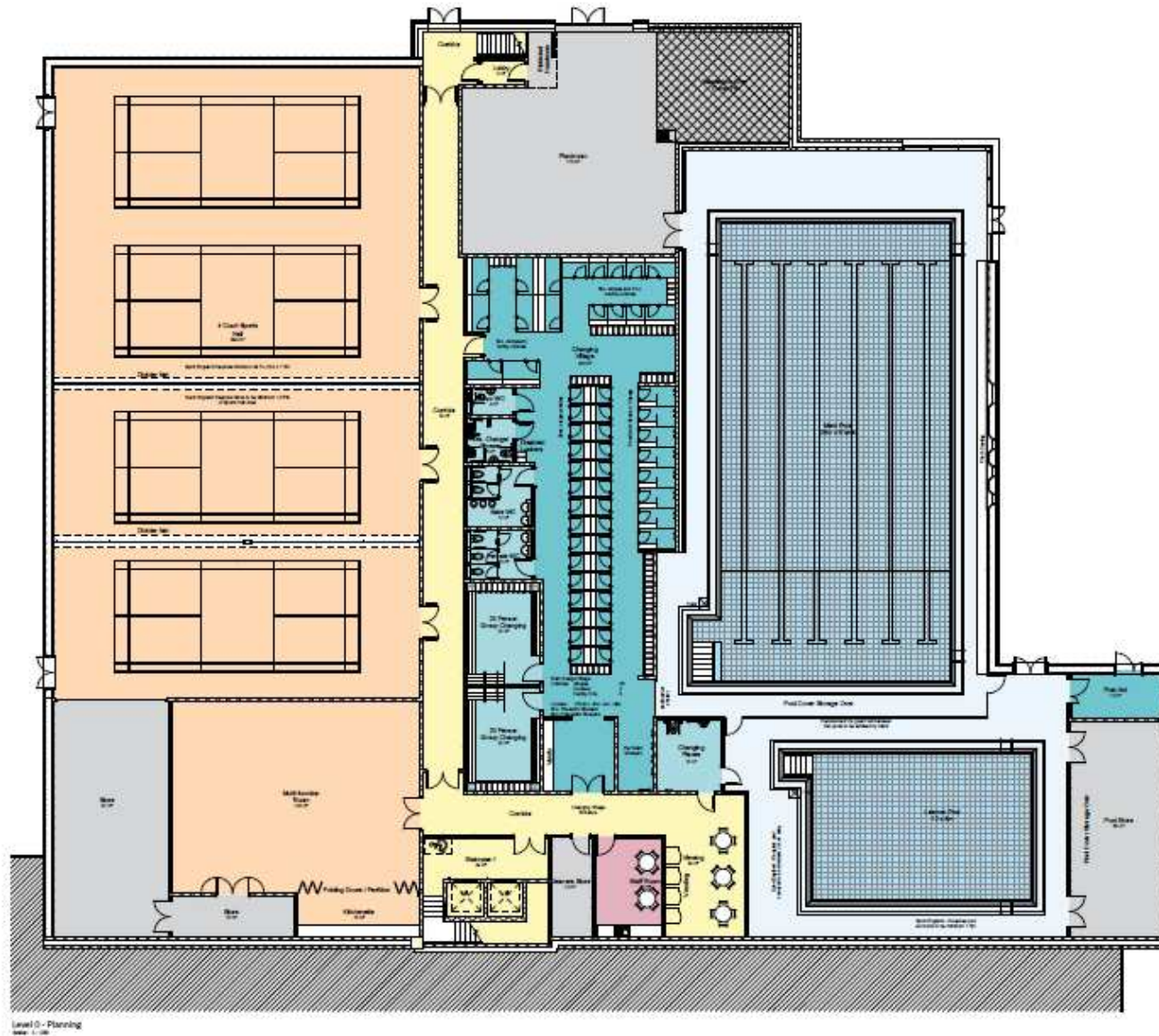

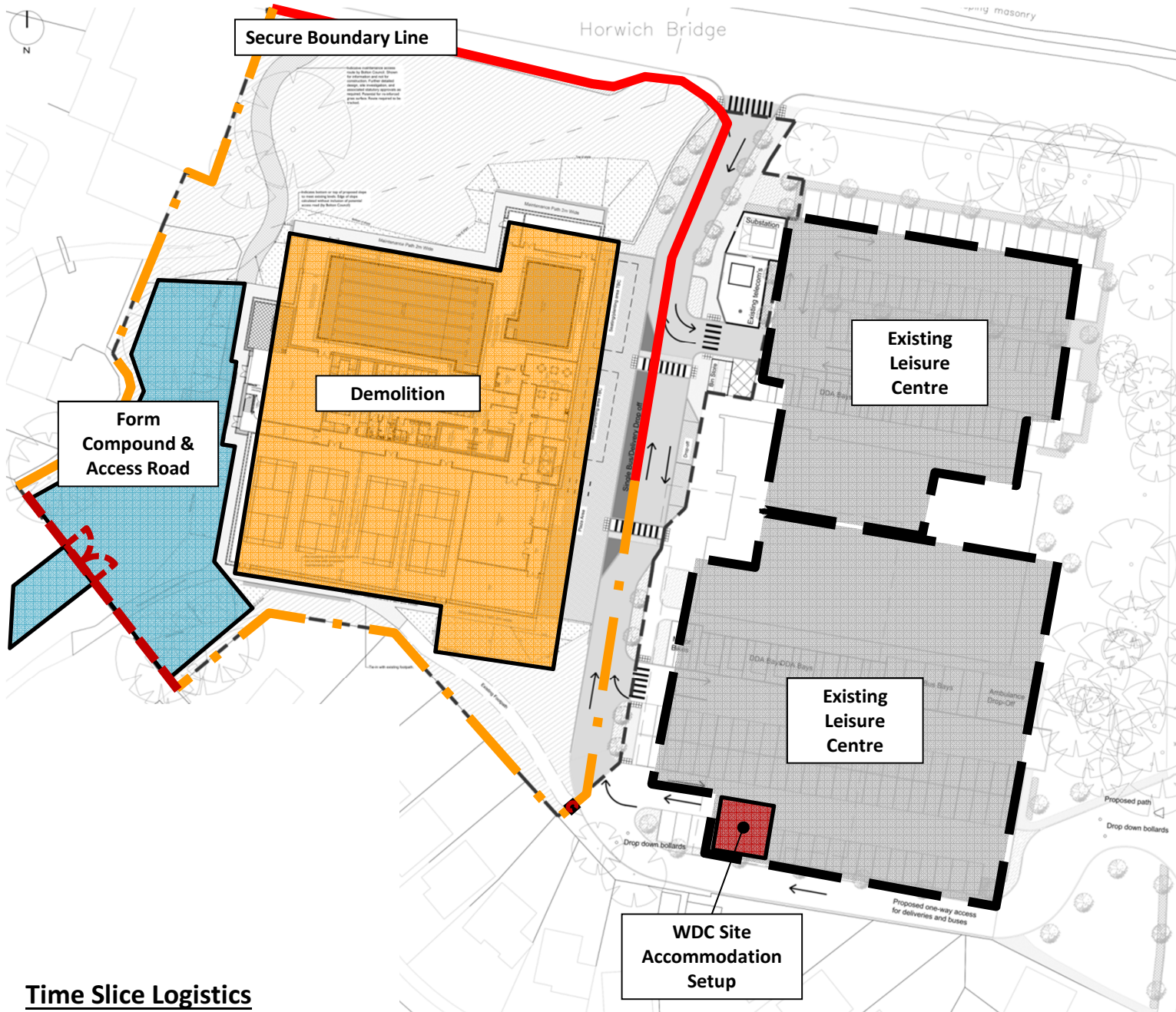
- Responsible through it's managing agent Serco for operating 7 leisure centres
