the Borough, contrary to Policy CG1.2.

The proposed works to the site, in particular the removal of the woodland understorey and the replacement of the existing railings with a close boarded fence, would fail to conserve and enhance the character of the existing physical environment of this part of North **Bolton**, contrary to Policy OA5.8 of Bolton's Core Strategy, nor would it conserve and enhance local distinctiveness or ensure development has regard to the overall landscape quality of the area and would therefore also be contrary to Policy CG3.2 of the Core Strategy.
