54. CORPORATE VOLUNTARY AND FAITH SECTOR FUNDING

Further to minute 52 of the previous meeting, the Chief Executive advised that the report had been considered by the External Organisations Scrutiny Committee, at its meeting on 10th March, 2011 whereby it was agreed to note the decision taken by the Executive Member.

The Chief Executive also requested the Executive Member's approval to the allocation of £18,000, identified from the Chief

Executive's Department budget, and £10,000 from the Adult and Social Care budget towards the Bolton Lads and Girls Club which would be in addition to the funding proposed by Children's Services.

The Executive Member AGREED to the proposed allocation of funding to the Bolton Lads and Girls Club.
