#### 45. MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting of the Schools Forum held on 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2021 were submitted.

#### 46. 2022-2023 DSG BUDGET REPORT

The Director of People and the Deputy Chief Executive submitted a joint report which summarised the Dedicated Schools Grant (DSG) position for 2022-23 and also sought agreement on recommendations to the Executive Cabinet Member.

The report explained that the initial 2022-23 DSG for Bolton, before academy recoupment and high needs places deduction, had been confirmed as £332,780,000.

The report went on to give specific details in terms of –

- Schools funding formula consultation;
- Transfer 0.5% of schools budget to high needs;
- Minimum funding guarantee;
- 2022/23 formula details,
- The growth fund;

- Reconciliation to DSG Schools Block;
- De-delegation;
- Central Schools Services Block;
- Early Years Block;
- High Needs Block;
- Schools Supplementary grant: and
- Pupil Premium.

Members in their discussions referred to matters around special school funding.

Resolved – That the Executive Cabinet Member be recommended to approve the following, as detailed in the report, viz-

- (i) The transfer of 0.5% of the Schools Block to the high Needs Block by not including the area cost adjustment within the formula.
- (ii) Adopt a minimum funding guarantee of 2% per pupil.
- (iii) Approve the 2022-23 unit values in appendix B.
- (iv) Growth Fund criteria
- (v) De-delegation levels.
- (vi) Central Schools Services expenditure.
- (vii) Early Years expenditure.
