22. MONITORING OF EXECUTIVE CABINET MEMBER DECISIONS

The Borough Solicitor submitted a report which set out the details of previous Executive Cabinet Member decisions together with an update on the action and progress.

The Executive Cabinet Member NOTED the report.

23. PUBLICATION OF THE RIGHTS OF WAY IMPROVEMENT PLAN 2018-2028

The Director of Place submitted a report which sought approval for the rights of Way Improvement Plan, 2018-2028.

The report explained that the Council had a statutory duty, to publish a Rights of Way Improvement Plan and undertake a review every 10 years.

In June, 2018 a report was submitted to Place Policy Development Group presenting a draft Rights of Way Improvement Plan for public consultation.

A 12 week public consultation exercise was undertaken starting in August, 2018 and ending in November, 2018.

The draft plan had been amended to incorporate relevant comments made following the consultation.

The Executive Cabinet Member AUTHORISED publication of the Rights of Way Improvement Plan 2018-2028.

24. WAITING RESTRICTIONS, VARIOUS STREETS, OBJECTIONS REPORT

The Director of Place submitted a report which set out details of objections which had been received to the proposed introduction of waiting restrictions on Lecturers Close, St. Marks Street, Adam Street, Rothwell Street, Cochrane Street, Nile Street, Coe Street, Sidney Street, Green Lane and Viking Street, Bolton.

The report explained that the Director of Place had agreed the promotion of waiting restrictions on the streets referred to within this report for the purposes of reducing obstruction, and improving sightlines on some roads within this report

The proposal was advertised in December, 2018 and 3 responses were received to the proposals following consultation.

The Executive Cabinet Member, having considered the objections and the views of Ward Members, APPROVED the introduction of the restrictions, as amended, as indicated in the report.
