80. EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

Resolved – That, in accordance with Section 100A (4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the public be excluded from the meeting for the following item of business on the grounds that it involves the likely disclosure of exempt information as specified in paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Act; and that it be deemed that, in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in their exemption outweighs the public interest in their disclosure.

81. STRATEGIC INVESTMENT

The Director of Corporate Resources submitted a report which sought members approval to provide support for a key asset in Greater Manchester as a result of the global pandemic COVID-19 and to delegate authority to the Chief Executive, the Director of Corporate Resources and the Borough Solicitor to carry out the necessary actions and activities.

Members were advised that there was an urgent requirement for the local authority to consider support to a key asset in Greater Manchester as a result of the global pandemic COVID-19. It was stated that the asset was of strategic economic and financial importance to Manchester, GM and the North West and provided a significant number of jobs to local residents.

In terms of funding, the Council would access the Public Works Loans Board (PWLB) as part of its capital strategy and it was anticipated that income would exceed costs over the lifetime of the investment. Resolved – (i) That in accordance with paragraph 18 of Part 4, Access to Information Procedure Rules and paragraph 17 of Part 4 section E, Scrutiny Procedure Rules of the Council's constitution, and having consulted with and/or obtained the agreement of the relevant statutory officers and elected members, the matter be approved as urgent, in that any delay caused by the key decision and call-in processes, would seriously prejudice the legal and financial position of the Council and the interests of residents of Bolton and the decisions be exempt from call-in.

(ii) That the request to consider support for a key asset in Greater Manchester as a result of the global pandemic COVID-19 be approved and the Chief Executive, the Director of Corporate Resources and the Borough Solicitor be granted delegated authority to carry out the necessary actions and activities.
