- Theft of Motor Vehicle down 75%
- Robbery down 60%
- Criminal Damage down 57%
- Serious Violent Crime down 75%

Councillor Adia thanked Sgt Knight and the neighbourhood policing team on behalf of the Area Forum for their efforts in reducing crime and anti-social behaviour in Rumworth.
