7. WASTE AND RECYCLING REVIEW – PHASE 1

Further to minute 3 of the previous meeting, the Director of Place submitted a revised report which set out the Phase 1 option proposals regarding the Waste & Recycling Service, totalling £66k per annum by 2021/22, which would contribute to the Service's savings target of £193k.

Members were reminded that at the previous meeting the decision was called-in to Scrutiny Committee, however, discussions had since taken place and the report had now been amended to reflect the concerns expressed. As a result, the call-in had been withdrawn

The report set out proposals which, if approved, would achieve a total of £66k saving per annum by 2021/22, which would contribute to the Service's savings target of £193k. Further options were being explored to address the remaining budget shortfall and would be brought forward for consideration in Autumn 2020 as a second phase of the review.

No implications of a legal nature had been noted. No staffing implications had been noted in association with the proposals made within the report.
