Legal Corporate Property Chief Exec's	Further to the minute, a Land Registry search has been undertaken which has identified the people who own the land around the Stocks. The Stocks themselves are showing up as unregistered. Discussions have been had with Corporate Property who are not in a position to formally adopt the Stocks. With regards the repair work, this was commissioned by the Area Forum at a cost of £450 and is now complete.
2	A resident asked if yellow lines could be painted on Sandhole Road?	Highways	Highways have looked into the possibility of installing double yellow lines on Sandhole Rd and carried out an assessment. The cost of this would in the region of £3,500. This would be added to the list of other potential schemes that the Cllrs are currently looking at.
3	An update on status and ownership of Kearsley Town Hall was requested? Concerns were that neighbouring properties were depreciating due to its condition.
