1	A question was asked in relation to the Village Stocks at Ringley and who was responsible for the maintenance, as there had been damage to some of the fencing caused by a road accident.	Legal Corporate Property Chief Exec's	<p>Further to the minute, a Land Registry search has been undertaken which has identified the people who own the land around the Stocks. The Stocks themselves are showing up as unregistered.</p> <p>Discussions have been had with Corporate Property who are not in a position to formally adopt the Stocks.</p> <p>With regards the repair work, this was commissioned by the Area Forum at a cost of £450 and is now complete.</p>
2	A resident asked if yellow lines could be painted on Sandhole Road?	Highways	<p>Highways have looked into the possibility of installing double yellow lines on Sandhole Rd and carried out an assessment. The cost of this would in the region of £3,500.</p> <p>This would be added to the list of other potential schemes that the Cllrs are currently looking at.</p>
3	An update on status and ownership of Kearsley Town Hall was requested? Concerns were that neighbouring properties were depreciating due to its condition.	Legal Chief Exec's	<p>A Land Registry search has been undertaken and the site is owned by someone from Farnworth.</p> <p>As stated at the meeting, there are currently no planning applications for this site.</p>
