- **The 2011 Census;** the census count, which takes place every 10 years, is an national stock take of the country's population. Find out why it's important for everyone in Halliwell to complete the census.
- **Review of 2010, looking forward to 2011;** Come along to this meeting and hear how issues raised during 2010 have been tackled, you can also find out about how devolved budgets have been used to support projects in the area. The review will also include an update on the projects for 2011.
