Summary:

The Director of Place agreed the promotion of waiting restrictions on the streets referred to within this report for the purposes of reducing the high KSI rate in the area, reducing obstruction, removing an un-utilised permit holder parking bay and improving access into some roads within this report

The proposal was advertised in September/October 2017 and responses were received to the proposals following consultation. This breaks down as 5 notifications of objection and 1 notification of support. This report sets out the reasons given for the representations and gives a response to them.

Having considered the objections and the views of Ward Members, the Director of Place recommends the Executive Cabinet Member Environmental Services to agree the introduction of the restrictions indicated in this report as amended.

Background information

1. The Executive Member is reminded that the restrictions originally proposed in this order were intended to address complaints of obstruction in these locations, with the intention of reducing obstructions, improving sightlines improving safety and assisting with traffic flow.

Objection/Representation

2. Following advertising of the proposals, we received a total of 6 representations 5 of which were objections and one of support details of which are as follows:

Tonge Moor Road: Objectors 1 and 2 are is concerned about the pressure on parking on

Tonge Moor Road by the introduction of these restrictions, taking into

account the resiting and enlargement of a local supermarket.

Bradford Street: Objector 3 concerns that the waiting restrictions will result in loss of

parking for staff.

Plevna/Eagle St: Objector 4 has concerns that customers will no longer be able to park

in the area.

Bury Old Road: Objector 5 queries if we are targeting the right area on the Industrial

Estate.

Bury Old Road: Supporter 1 supports the implementation of the restrictions as

advertised in the Industrial Estate area

Observations

- 3. The proposed restrictions are intended to address indiscriminate parking in the areas preventing access/egress from/to other locations. The minimum lengths believed appropriate are proposed by this order.
- **4.** With regard to loss of customer parking, this is a genuine concern and that restricted parking times to cover the same restrictions as the loading/waiting restrictions as detailed in this report may be appropriate. The schedule has been amended accordingly.
- 5. Due to an inadvertent oversight, the length of restriction for Goodwin Street was considerably shorter than required. In the originally proposed length, they would not meet the purpose of preventing obstruction. In order to expedite the restrictions to the correct length they have been increased. The owner of the premises effected by this order has been consulted and is in favour of the increased restrictions.
- **6.** It is therefore proposed that this order, as amended, be approved:

Consultation

- **7.** Representatives of the Chief Constable, County Fire and Rescue Officer, North West Ambulance Service and Chief Executive of Transport for Greater Manchester have been consulted and have raised no objections to the proposals.
- **8.** Parking Services, Licensing and Waste Management have been consulted regarding this report and Parking Services and have not commented on the proposals.

Views of Ward Members

9. The views of Ward Members have been requested and have made no comment on the proposals.

Financial implications and implementation

10. The cost of the promoting this traffic regulation order is £3,075 including staff costs and legal fees. This will be met by a grant from the Greater Manchester Casualty Reduction Partnership together with the additional cost of £1,827 for lining and signing as the part of Bradford Street area works. The cost for the implementation of the remaining lining and signing works will be split between Peer Engineering, (£700) and the Tonge with Haulgh area forum, (£2,000). If approved, the new restrictions will be implemented as soon as the necessary legal processes have been completed.

Recommendation

11. Having considered the objections and the views of Ward Members, the Director of Place recommends the Executive Cabinet Member Environmental Services to agree the introduction of the proposed restrictions as amended and indicated in this order.
