34. ANNUAL PERFORMANCE ASSESSMENT – CARE QUALITY COMMISSION

A report of the Director of Adult and Community Services was submitted which outlined the Care Quality Commission Assessment of Bolton Council for 2008/2009 following an inspection.

The report advised that the assessment showed improved performance, with only one of the seven outcomes assessed being not classed as Excellent. This had improved from two in 2008. With regard to economic wellbeing, particularly focused on employment opportunities for people with disabilities, and Bolton had been assessed as performing well.

Information on the areas where the Council did well/needed to improve was included in the Briefing Note appended to the report.

The report also outlined how the assessment would be shared with stakeholders using the Council's website and writing to partners to ensure continued involvement and improvement in meeting the seven outcomes.
